LOCAL RULES

- 1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 18.3)
 - a. Marked by white stakes.
 - b. Over any boundary.
 - c. Into or over the footpath between the 9^{th} and 10^{th} holes.
 - d. The Clubhouse
- 2. PENALTY AREAS (Rule 17) Marked by red stakes.
- 3. ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS (INCLUDING IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS) Drop freely within one club-length of the nearest point of relief not nearer the hole.
 - a. GROUND UNDER REPAIR Marked by white lines. Where defined as no-play zones in GUR (Rule 16.1f) it is compulsory to take relief.
 - b. SPRINKLER HEADS

All pop-up sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief may be taken under Rule 16.1b. Additionally, a player my take relief if the sprinkler head is on the line of play and within two club-lengths of the ball.

- c. PROTECTION OF YOUNG TREES Players must take relief from trees which are less than two club-lengths in height, staked or have a soil bund (Rule 19.1).
- d. All paths and deep tractor tracks are obstructions and relief is available under rule 16.1.
- 4. INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE COURSE
 - a. Walls supporting teeing areas and steps to teeing areas, and concrete steps and patio up to the Clubhouse are all integral parts of the course and relief is only available under penalty (Rule 19.1).
- 5. SINGLE PLAYERS May play only one ball.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

If the Klaxon sounds when you are playing (because of adverse weather conditions; one prolonged note of the klaxon) you must cease play and return to the Clubhouse immediately. You must not take shelter on the course. Play will resume when the klaxon is sounded after play suspension (two short notes of the klaxon). Please take extra care when crossing the bridleway after playing 9th and 17th holes, as cyclists and pedestrians using it have the right of way.
